How we use your information

- This privacy notice tells you what to expect when Big Cat Boat Charters Ltd collects personal information. We will never share or sell your personal information.

Your information in our office administration

- Big Cat Boat Charters Ltd will protect your personal information in line with The Data Protection Act 2018. As laid out below.

Consent

- Individuals must clearly consent to the processing of their personal data. They can withdraw their consent at any time, and the process must be as easy as opting in. The opting in from will be clearly visible in the booking process.

Rights

- Individuals have the right to access, rectification, erasure, restriction of processing, data portability, and to object.

Data protection principles

We will not associate any data gathered from this site with any personally identifying information from any source. If we do want to collect personally identifiable information through our website, we will be up front about this. We will make it clear when we collect personal information.
